ELIGIBILITY

MAP is looking for talented candidates to bring us a new and different perspective at work, and internships are open to applicants of all nationalities. Previous experience of working in a museum or gallery is not mandatory, however, applicants are expected to be enrolled in or have completed degrees in art history, history, museology, conservation studies or related fields. Passionate candidates from other disciplines may choose to apply, only if they feel their educational background would be of relevance to specific departments or projects, and will only be considered if their application is deemed relevant to the scope of that department or project.

DATES & DETAILS

Terms

All internships require a minimum 6-week commitment of 40 hours per week, and interns will be expected to follow MAP's work timings.

Participants may arrange for academic credit through their school, but it is not a requirement from MAP. The dates of the internships remain flexible, and applicants may provide preferential dates based on their availability on the application form.

While the Museum's flagship building remains under construction, interns are placed at our office premises which houses a significant part of our collections, as well as the conservation lab and education centres situated nearby – all in Central Bangalore.

MAP does not provide airfare or accommodation, however, a grant stipend of INR 15,000 (\$215) per month will be provided to assist interns with their living expenses. Support for any research travel will be discussed on a case-by-case basis. Please note that grant funds may be subject to state taxes and deductions.

International Applicants

International candidates are responsible for ensuring that they have valid legal status under applicable Indian visa regulations while participating in a MAP internship. Although the Museum will act as your host institution, MAP does not sponsor visas for interns. Please be aware that obtaining a visa can be a lengthy process and must be completed well in advance of the agreed upon internship start date. If you are offered an internship but do not have your visa before the start date of the program, your internship will be cancelled.

How to Apply

Please apply using the online application found [here](#). Candidates can choose to apply for more than one type of internship and will be assigned based on availability and suitability. As part of your application, you will be required to submit a copy of your current CV/résumé, two writing samples, a recommendation letter and a copy of your latest transcript, if applying from an American University. Typically, the most appropriate recommenders are university faculty members who can address your academic performance. Other recommenders may include past or current employers in relevant fields who are familiar with your skills and abilities.

Selected candidates will be notified of their acceptance within 4 weeks of their application, and invited to a Skype interview.
